## ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3039 (First Reprint)

To the General Assembly:

Pursuant to Article V, Section I, Paragraph 14 of the New Jersey Constitution, I am returning Assembly Bill No. 3039 (First Reprint) with my recommendations for reconsideration.

Lupus is a serious chronic, autoimmune disease that impacts the lives of thousands of New Jersey residents every day. While I applaud the sponsors' intent to raise awareness and better educate health care providers and the general public on the harmful effects of lupus, I believe the bill should be amended to instead launch a one-year effort that will swiftly implement the provisions of this bill. I support the development of a comprehensive lupus education and awareness plan, including the creation of a directory of lupus-related health care services and a listing of health care providers who specialize in the diagnosis and treatment of lupus, and I earnestly await the efforts of a one-year task force I recommend herein.

Raising awareness of public health concerns and the impact of chronic disease is a laudable goal. To that end, I was pleased that, earlier this summer, the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention awarded the New Jersey Department of Health a grant for the prevention and management of diabetes, heart disease, and other chronic diseases. This initiative will help coordinate and integrate all State programs that address chronic disease prevention and disease management, as well as promote an overall wellness program and culture in New Jersey.

The efforts of the task force embodied in my recommendation will undoubtedly aid the Department in the development of the chronic disease initiative and, therefore, it is evermore critical that the task force quickly perform its important work.
