

## PARDON

WHEREAS, Elizabeth J. Griffith, on July 14, 2015 was issued a summons for one count of Unlawful Possession of a weapon in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5(b) in the Township of Jersey City, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey and one count of Unlawful Possession of a weapon in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5(b) in the Town of Harrison, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Elizabeth J. Griffith, has made a written application to the Governor for a pardon for the aforesaid offense, and the State Parole Board, upon request of the Governor, in accordance with the law, has made an investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding said application for a Pardon;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by the Constitution of the State of New Jersey and the statutes of this State, do hereby grant Elizabeth J. Griffith, a full and free Pardon for all criminal charges arising from the summons occurring July 14, 2015 to include the aforesaid crimes, and this order is applicable solely to said criminal charges, and to no other.

This Order is subject to revocation at any time, at the discretion of the Governor, without notice.
