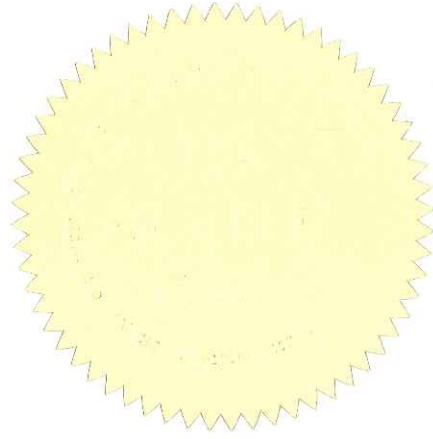
## PARDON

WHEREAS, Joshua Velez was arrested on September 6, 2015, and was thereafter charged with one count of Unlawful Possession of a Weapon in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5b and one count of Unlawful Possession of Hollow-Nose Bullets in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-3f in the Township of North Bergen, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Joshua Velez has made a written application to the Governor for a pardon for the aforesaid offenses, and the State Parole Board, upon request of the Governor, in accordance with the law, has made an investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding said application for a Pardon;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by the Constitution of the State of New Jersey and the statutes of this State, do hereby grant Joshua Velez a full and free Pardon for all criminal charges arising from the arrest occurring on September 6, 2015, to include the aforesaid crimes, and this Order is applicable solely to said criminal charges and to no other.

This Order is subject to revocation at any time, at the discretion of the Governor, without notice.
