



ORDER FOR COMMUTATION OF SENTENCE

WHEREAS, Hisashi K. D. Pompey was arrested on December 26, 2011, and was thereafter convicted of one count of Unlawful Possession of a Weapon in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5(b) in the Superior Court, Law Division (Criminal), Bergen County, New Jersey and was sentenced on September 20, 2013, under Indictment No. 12-05-00709-1 to a five-year term of imprisonment with a three-year mandatory minimum; and

WHEREAS, Hisashi K. D. Pompey caused to be made a written application to the Governor for executive clemency for the aforesaid crime of which he was convicted, and the State Parole Board, upon request of the Governor in accordance with the law, has made an investigation of the facts and circumstances concerning said application for executive clemency;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by the Constitution of New Jersey and the statutes of this State, do hereby grant to the said Hisashi K. D. Pompey, a commutation of the aforesaid sentence to time served, and satisfied on April 14, 2017.

This Order is subject to revocation at any time, at the discretion of the Governor, without notice.
