PARDON

WHEREAS, Michael A. Golden was arrested on November 26, 2013 and was thereafter convicted of violating N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4, which requires a permit to carry a handgun, in the Township of Mahwah, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey; and


WHEREAS, Michael A. Golden has made a written application to the Governor for a pardon for the aforesaid offense, and the State Parole Board, upon request of the Governor, in accordance with the law, has made an investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding said application for a Pardon;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by the Constitution of the State of New Jersey and the statutes of this State, do hereby grant Michael A. Golden a full and free Pardon for all criminal charges and convictions arising from the arrest occurring November 26, 2013 to include the aforesaid crime, and this order is applicable solely to said criminal charges and convictions, and to no other.


This Order is subject to revocation at any time, at the discretion of the Governor, without notice.
