

Memorandum

The following memo is based on a National Research survey of 600 likely Republican Primary voters in the state of New Jersey. The survey was conducted May 6-8, 2025. The margin of error for this survey is +/- 4% at the 95% confidence interval.

State of the GOP Primary

Almost three weeks into early voting and with just one month left before Primary Election Day, Jack Ciattarelli holds a 31-point advantage over his nearest competitor, Bill Spadea. Jack's ballot advantage over Spadea is now the largest it has ever been, despite the fact that Spadea's campaign has started to spend significant resources in attack ads on Ciattarelli, while trying to explain away Spadea's repeated attacks on President Trump following the 2020 election.

Gubernatorial Primary Ballot

Jack Ciattarelli currently leads Bill Spadea 54%-23%, with Jon Bramnick receiving 10% and Mario Kranjac 2%. Jack's 31-point advantage represents his largest lead yet. Among voters who are favorable to President Trump, or approve of the job the President is doing, Jack is winning by 32 points.
